Under the supervision of the Mental Wellness Team Lead, the Wellness Worker is responsible for enhancing existing Mental Health and Wellness in Roseau River Anishinaabe First Nation Community Members. The successful applicant will work as part of a team to build capacity within the RRAFN community while contributing to the improvement of the quality of life of youth, adults, and their families by ensuring they receive services.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assess patients' emotional and behavioural presentation, through the application of skills in trauma informed care.
- Support youth, parents, or adults in lifespan development activities in the context of their mental health, through supportive counselling, strategic interventions, psychosocial development, and guidance in activities of daily living.
- Assist in development, implementation and facilitation of group programs as identified by community needs.
- Work collaboratively with all members of the Mental Health team to ensure all resources are utilized to support
 program/service activities.
- Provide individuals and groups of all ages with addictions and mental health information through group presentations and through provision of resource materials.
- Provide in-person therapeutic interventions youth, parents, and adults, in office, home. or school settings.
